Section 13-315.6—Area Requirements

All M1 W1—Industrial Park Districts shall be located on a site having a gross area of not less than twenty (20) acres, and no individual lot shall have a net area of less than two (2) acres.

Section 13-315.7—Yards AND SETBACKS

No front yard in any M1 W1—Industrial Park District shall measure less than fifty feet (50'); rear and side yards shall measure not less than thirty feet (30') for principal structures, and not less than twenty-five feet (25') for accessory structures. With the exception of freeways, expressways and limited access major highways, all yards shall be adjacent to the public right of way line. EACH STRUCTURE IN AN M1 W1—INDUSTRIAL PARK DISTRICT SHALL BE SET BACK NOT LESS
