Section 13-317.1—Special Exceptions

The following special exceptions shall be permitted in M3 W3 Heavy Industrial Districts:

- (1) Abattoirs and stockyards (commercial).
- (2) Sand and gravel operations.
- (3) Sanitary landfills.
- (4) Junk vards.
- (5) Radioactive waste handling.
- (6) Storage of inflammable, explosive, incendiary, and toxic material.
- (2) JUNK YARDS.
- (3) RADIOACTIVE WASTE HANDLING.
- (4) SAND AND GRAVEL OPERATIONS.
- (5) SANITARY LANDFILLS.
- (6) ORE STORAGE.
- (7) STORAGE OF INFLAMMABLE, EXPLOSIVE, INCENDIARY, AND TOXIC MATERIAL.
 - (8) TANNERIES.

Section 13-317.2—Area Requirements

- (a) Each lot shall have an area of not less than six thousand (6,000) square feet.
- (b) Not more than eighty per cent (80%) of the net area of any lot may be covered by a structure (including accessory structures and uses, and off-street parking).
- (c) Each lot shall have a depth of not less than one hundred feet (100').
