Jurors," to increase the daily pay of jurors who attend the Circuit Court of Montgomery County, and to give the County Council discretion as to the amount given to the jurors for mileage per diem coverage.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 19(a) of Article 51 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Supplement), title "Juries," subtitle "Qualification and Selection of Jurors," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

19.

Jurors in Washington County shall receive eight dollars per (a) day and a reasonable amount, in the discretion of the County Commissioners for each mile over five miles in going to and returning from court; in Queen Anne's County, seven dollars and fifty cents per day; in Caroline, Harford, Kent, [Montgomery,] Somerset and Talbot counties, and in Baltimore City, ten dollars per day, and in Anne Arundel County, fifteen dollars per day, and no extra allowance shall be given either for mileage or overtime in Anne Arundel, Caroline, Harford, [Montgomery,] Somerset and Talbot counties and in Baltimore City; in Carroll County, eight dollars per day; and in all other counties, except Allegany, Baltimore, Calvert, Charles, Frederick, Garrett, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, Prince George's, St. Mary's and Wicomico counties, five dollars per day for each and every day they shall attend the several courts of this State as jurors and fifteen cents for each mile over five miles for going to and returning from the court, once in each term, to be paid by the counties, respectively, in which courts are held. In Baltimore County, jurors shall receive per diem compensation in such amount as shall be set, from time to time, by the judges of the Circuit Court of Baltimore County. Jurors in Frederick County and Montgomery County shall receive fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day for each and every day they shall attend the Circuit Court of Frederick County within their respective counties as jurors and IN FREDERICK COUNTY a reasonable amount in the discretion of the County Commissioners or County Council, for each mile going to and returning from the

(House Bill 97)
