## CHAPTER 103

(Senate Bill 757)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 9 of Article 75½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Supplement), title "Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors," to correct an erroneous reference therein.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 9 of Article 75½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Supplement), title "Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

The secretary of the Board shall receive and account for all moneys derived under the provisions of this article, and shall pay the same monthly to the State Treasurer, who shall keep such moneys in such banks as he deems proper and such moneys shall become general funds of the State.
