

CHAPTER 183

(House Bill 960)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 61-5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County (1965 Edition, being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County," subtitle "Title III City Town and Village Laws," subtitle "Subtitle 3. Villages," subheading "Chevy Chase Section 3," to increase the amount that may be expended by the Chevy Chase Citizens Committee of Section 3 for material or work without advertising.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 61-5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County (1965 Edition, being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County," subtitle "Title III City Town and Village Laws," subtitle "Subtitle 3 Villages," subheading "Chevy Chase Section 3," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

61-5.

Said Chevy Chase Citizens' Committee of said Section 3, shall not expend for material or work, a sum exceeding [three hundred dollars (\$300.00)] *fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)* without having first advertised the specifications therefor and inviting bids for the same, after which said committee may purchase such material or make contract for such work, or have such work done by employed labor, or otherwise, as it may deem best, and; provided further, that said committee may make contracts after due advertisement for lighting or supplying said Section 3 of said village with water for periods of five years, but no longer period at a time, and; provided further, that no member of said citizens' committee shall furnish any supplies of any kind or contract in any manner with said citizens' committee.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
