(b) Gill net.—~~[\$2.50]~~ \$5.00 for each 100 yards or fraction thereof.

(c) Pound net.—\$10.00 for each net.

(d) Haul seine.—\$3.00 for each 100 yards.

(e) Hook-and-line.—\$10.00 for each person licensed.

All fees shall be deposited to the credit of The Fisheries Research and Development Fund.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

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#### CHAPTER 207

(House Bill 1317)

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Charles County, from time to time, to borrow not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) in order to finance the completion of construction and development of the Gilbert Run Park in said County, as herein defined, and to effect such borrowing by the issuance and sale at public or private sale of its general obligation bonds in like par amount; empowering said County to fix and determine, by resolution, the form, tenor, interest rates or method of arriving at the same, terms, including redemption and registration provisions, conditions, maturities and all other details incident or necessary to the issuance, sale and delivery of said bonds, without reference to any other law heretofore enacted; prescribing the method and manner of selling said bonds; empowering said County to sell said bonds at, above or below the par value thereof; empowering said County to refund any of said bonds purchased or redeemed in advance of maturity; empowering said County to apply to the payment of principal and interest of said bonds and said refunding bonds any funds received from the State of Maryland and the United States of America, which may be properly allocable to said purpose; empowering said County to disburse said borrowed funds, or any portion thereof, to any board, agency, department or other public body which is empowered to construct, operate or maintain the type of project or projects herein defined in Charles County; empowering and directing said County to contract to levy and to levy, impose and collect annually ad valorem taxes which, in addition to the State and Federal allotments, if any, will provide funds sufficient for the payment of said maturing principal and interest; exempting said bonds and said refunding bonds and the interest thereon from all State, county and municipal taxation in the State of Maryland; and providing that the power to incur indebtedness and issue bonds therefor under the provisions of this Act is additional and
