"Mining," subheading "Strip Mining," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(a) There is hereby created a standing committee which shall be known as the Land Reclamation Committee, hereafter referred to as the "Committee," to be composed of nine members as follows: the Director of the Maryland Geological Survey, who shall act as chairman; the chairman of the soil conservation district supervisors of Allegany County, and the chairman of the soil conservation district supervisors of Garrett County or their designated representatives; two members representing the mining industry, appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate for three-year terms is to represent the mining industry or their designated alternates; the Director or his representative of the following State agencies; the Department of Game and Inland Fish, Fish and Wildlife Administration, the Department of Forests and Parks, the Department of Water Resources and the Bureau of Mines. The Committee members shall serve without compensation, other than reimbursement for travel and actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under this subheading. Funds for expenses will be provided for in the budget of the Maryland Geological Survey. The Committee shall meet at the chairman's request, but in no case shall the meetings be held less often than twice a year. A quorum shall consist of five (5) or more members. A majority vote of the full Committee shall be necessary to approve any action.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

## CHAPTER 237

(Senate Bill 392)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 5.03(a) of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume), title "Zoning and Planning," subtitle "Subdivision Control," to include public school sites in the list of those areas for which provision may be made by zoning regulations, and to clarify the language therein.
