- (2) The clerk of the board shall mail all such authorizations to the board of the proper county or Baltimore City. Upon receipt of this authorization from the forwarding county or Baltimore City, the clerk of the board upon a comparison of the voter's signature with his signature as it appears on the registration records shall remove the voter's registration from the records and retain the cancellation authorization in the records of said board.
- (c) The cancellation authorization required by subsections (a) (2) and (b)(1) of this section shall be on a form substantially as follows:

CANCELLATION AUTHORIZATION

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1971.
