SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 23 of Article 58A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1957 Edition, 1968 Replacement Volume and 1970 Supplement), title "Loans—Consumer," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Any licensee and any officer or employee of a licensee who shall knowingly violate the provisions of Sections 16, 17 or 19 of this Article, and any person, copartnership, association or corporation, whether licensed under the provisions of this Article or not, which shall knowingly violate the provisions of Sections 1, 21 or 22(a) of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable for each offense by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
