

ING APPROPRIATION FROM AN AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT (AND WITH THE FURTHER PROVISION THAT IF ONLY A PORTION OF THIS TOTAL SUM IS PROVIDED BY THE AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, THE STATE APPROPRIATION SHALL BE REDUCED TO THE SAME AMOUNT) 100,000

(F) TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE TO MEMORIAL STADIUM ON 33RD STREET (THIS SUM TO BE REPAID TO THE STATE OF MARYLAND BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, FROM REVENUE SOURCES OTHER THAN A PROPERTY TAX LEVIED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE AT SUCH TIMES AND UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS MAY BE PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS; BUT THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL INCLUDE AS A CONDITION PRECEDENT TO THE GRANTING OF THESE MONIES THAT THERE SHALL BE VALID AND BINDING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, OR ONE OF ITS AGENCIES, AND (1) THE CORPORATION OR ORGANIZATION KNOWN GENERALLY AS THE BALTIMORE COLTS, OR ITS SUCCESSOR, AND (2) THE CORPORATION OR ORGANIZATION KNOWN GENERALLY AS THE BALTIMORE ORIOLES, OR ITS SUCCESSOR, BOTH AGREEMENTS TO THE EFFECT, AMONG OTHER PROVISIONS THAT EACH CORPORATION OR ORGANIZATION AND THE ATHLETIC TEAM OWNED AND OPERATED BY EACH WILL CONTINUE TO MAKE FULL AND REGULAR USE OF MEMORIAL STADIUM UNTIL AT LEAST JANUARY 1, 1976) 7,000,000
