(b) In the exercise of this responsibility there is hereby created a State Department of Water Resources. This responsibility shall be exercised by the Department of Natural Resources, which shall have the powers and duties provided for in this article. In addition, the Department shall have those powers and duties formerly exercised by the Water Pollution Control Commission and the present Department of Geology, Mines and Water Resources which are transferred herein to the Department. Nothing in this article shall in any manner limit the responsibilities of the Department of Chesapeake Bay Affairs as provided for in Article 66C of this Code.
