and licenses shall be issued as prescribed by regulations of the Fish and Wildlife Administration.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1972.

CHAPTER 429

(Senate Bill 590)

AN ACT to add new Section 33A to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title "Health," subtitle "Miscellaneous Provisions," to follow immediately after Section 33 thereof; and to add new Section 6A to Article 62 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume), title "Marriages," to follow immediately after Section 6 thereof; to provide that information and services concerning sickle cell anemia and the sickle cell trait be made available to certain individuals applying for marriage licenses, TO REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN BLOOD TESTS PERFORMED ON PREGNANT WOMEN INCLUDE TESTS FOR SICKLE CELL ANEMIA, to establish statewide facilities for education concerning the detection and treatment of sickle cell anemia and the sickle cell trait, to establish an advisory committee, and matters generally relating thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That new Section 33A be and it is hereby added to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title
