WHEREAS, in amending this Section with respect to salary provisions there was an inadvertent omission of a paragraph concerning the traveling and incidental expenses; and

WHEREAS, it was not the intention of the General Assembly in the enactment of Chapter 705 of 1971 to omit or to discontinue the provisions relating to the payment of traveling and incidental expenses; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish without question the proper wording of this Section it is desirable to re-enact it and to make certain the provisions concerning traveling and incidental expenses are properly incorporated into the Section; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 3 of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume and 1971 Supplement), title "Workmen's Compensation," subtitle "Workmen's Compensation Commission," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

3.

- (a) The chairman of the Workmen's Compensation Commission of Maryland shall receive a salary of twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) per annum and each of the other members of the Commission shall receive a salary of twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000) per annum.
- (b) In addition to the salary provided in this section each commissioner shall be allowed his actual necessary traveling and incidental expenses AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July JUNE 1, 1972.

(House Bill 733)
