

## CHAPTER 622

(House Bill 1397)

AN ACT to add new Section 26C to Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title "Fees of Officers," subtitle "Sheriffs," to follow immediately after Section 26B thereof, to provide for certain fees the sheriff of Allegany County may charge for serving papers involved in any civil ~~or~~ ~~criminal~~ case arising in the District Court or Circuit Court.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That new Section 26C be and it is hereby added to Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title "Fees of Officers," subtitle "Sheriffs," to follow immediately after Section 26B thereof, and to read as follows:

**26C.**

*The Sheriff of Allegany County may charge and collect the following fees:*

(1) *For any action or service, ~~civil or criminal~~, IN ANY CIVIL CASE which arises in the District Court or Circuit Court involving only the serving of a paper and is not an act of execution or attachment, a fee of \$4.00.*

(2) *For any action or service, ~~civil or criminal~~, IN ANY CIVIL CASE which arises in the District Court or Circuit Court, involving a seizure or a taking into custody of any property, real or personal, or of any person, a fee of \$8.00. If the Sheriff incurs any actual expenses for the purpose of conserving and protecting property seized, he shall be entitled to reimbursement for these expenditures.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1972.

## CHAPTER 623

(House Bill 1415)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 51(g) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Supplement), title "County Commissioners," subtitle "County Treasurers," changing the maximum permissible salary of the Deputy Treasurer of Charles County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 51(g) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Supplement), title "County Commissioners," subtitle "County Treasurers," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments and to read as follows:
