- seven (7) days before the election. The application shall contain an affidavit, which need not be under oath but which shall set forth the following information under [upon] penalty of perjury:
- (1) The voters name and residence address, including the street and number, if any, or rural route, if any;
- (2) That the person is a qualified voter at the residence address given;
- (3) If the person voted at the preceding election, the residence address from which he voted; and
- (4) That the voter expects in good faith to be unable to vote in person for any of the reasons set out in Section 27-1 of this article.
