

Warning! The Absentee Voting Law provides that anyone who wilfully signs any false application or oath, or who wilfully does any act contrary to the terms and provisions of the Absentee Voting Law with intent to cast an illegal vote or to aid another in doing so, or who wilfully violates any of the provisions of that law or who applies for a ballot under any other name than his own, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than two years, or to both, in the discretion of the court. A FORM TO BE PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS.

[(2) Any qualified voter who is unable to vote in person because of physical disability shall complete the medical certificate required by Section 27-2 of this article, which shall be in substantially the following form and which certificate shall be filed with the boards at the same time this application is returned to the boards:

AN ACT to repeal Sections 155, 159, 160, 162, 163, 164, 165, 166, 167, 168, 169 and 170 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments," subtitle "The Executive Department," subheading "State Library" and to repeal the subheading "State Library" of that Article, title and subtitle; and to add a new Section 29B to Article 26 of the Annotated Code of
