THENCE, south 85° 13' 49" West 163.91 feet to a point,

THENCE, following thence along the lines of Alphonso B. Campos, described in Liber 1627 at folio 215, the following course and distances,

THENCE, north 10° 53′ 47″ West 880.88 feet, passing in transit a stone found at 0.57 feet on said line to a point,

THENCE, north 44° 18′ 41" West 387.28 feet to a point,

THENCE, north 87° 52′ 57" West 703.64 feet to an Iron pipe found,
