SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That new Section 1-217 (a) (155) be and it is hereby added to said Code, Title, Subtitle and Article, to follow immediately after Section 1-217 (a) (154) thereof, to read as follows:

Section 1-217 (a).

(155) Assessor's Aide. Graduation from a recognized high school and two (2) years of college training in engineering, mathematics, accounting, or related fields. Experience appraisal work in real estate, insurance or mortgages may be substituted for the college training on a year for year basis; or any equivalent combination of education and experience.

SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 17-706 (b) (7) to the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 17, "Taxation", Subtitle 7, "Miscellaneous Taxes", as added by Bill No. 25-71, to correct a technical error.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland*, That Section 17-706 (b) (7) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 17, "Taxation", Subtitle 7, "Miscellaneous Taxes", as added by Bill No. 25-71 be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Section 17-706 (b).

(7) Fuels sold, used or consumed when such fuels are used as a fuel in the manufacture, generation, refining or processing of artificial
