this credited service. Said actuarial computation shall be based on actual compensation received during the period of County service for which past service credit is desired. This option for the purchase of such service credits must be exercised by a participant within ninety (90) days following the effective date of this article and payments made and completed by July 1, 1974.

(c) Each employee may obtain credited service under the employees' retirement plan of the county for any employment with the county on or after January 1, 1949 which has not previously been credited to him under this plan. Before receiving such credited service, the employee shall pay into the employees' retirement plan of the county the amount of money actuarially determined necessary by the county to purchase in full this credited service. Said actuarial computation shall be based on actual compensation received during the period of County service for which past service credit is desired. Payments for such credited service must be completed within five (5) years after the date the employee elects to make the purchase.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law.
