- AN ACT to amend Chapter 18, title, "Police," of the Montgomery County Code, 1965, as amended, by repealing and re-enacting, with amendments, Section 18-2, title, "Superintendent under supervision of county executive," to provide that the Superintendent of Police be under the direct supervision of the Director of the Department of Police.
- Be It Enacted by the County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, that—
- SEC. 1. Section 18-2, Chapter 18, title "Police," of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 18-2. Superintendent under supervision of Director of the Department of Police.

The Superintendent of the County Police shall at all times be under the supervision and order of the Director of the Department of Police.

SEC. 2. Effective date.

This Act shall take effect on December 7, 1970.
