SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10 OF CHAPTER 179 OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1972, BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY WAIVED, INSOFAR AS THEY IMPOSE A TIME FOR PLACING UNDER CONTRACT THE ITEMS IN SECTION 5.2(L)(3)(I) IN CHAPTER 179 OF THE ACTS OF 1972 AND FOUND ON PAGES 513-514 OF THE LAWS OF 1972, REDESIGNATED AS SECTION 5.2(L)(3)(J) BY THIS ACT, MAKING AVAILABLE ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,741,700) FOR CAPITAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE ADDITION TO HOWARD HALL. THERE SHALL BE ALLOWED AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF TWO YEARS BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, FOR PLACING THESE PROJECTS UNDER CONTRACT. IF THESE PROJECTS SHALL NOT HAVE BEEN PLACED UNDER CONTRACT WITHIN A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, THEN IT SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN ABANDONED AND THE OTHER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10 OF CHAPTER 179 OF THE ACTS OF 1972 SHALL BE FULLY EFFECTIVE AS TO THESE PROJECTS.

SECTION [[2]] 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect [[July]] JUNE 1, 1973.
