

(V) PROMULGATING RULES OF CONDUCT OR PROCEDURE, OR GUIDELINES FOR STATE EMPLOYEES, STATE AGENCIES, OR PERSONS DEALING WITH THEM OR SUBJECT TO THEIR JURISDICTION OR CONTROL;

(2) A PROPOSAL, ORDER, OR DIRECTIVE OF THE SECRETARY OF A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT, CHANGING THE ORGANIZATION, PLACEMENT, OR NAME OF A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT WITHIN THE SECRETARY'S JURISDICTION AND APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

(3) AN AMENDMENT, MODIFICATION, OR REVOCATION OF ANY OF THE ABOVE.

15CB.

WHEN THE SECRETARY OF A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT INTENDS TO ISSUE AN ORDER OR DIRECTIVE CHANGING THE ORGANIZATION, PLACEMENT, OR NAME OF A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION, HE SHALL FIRST SUBMIT THE PROPOSAL TO THE GOVERNOR. THE GOVERNOR MAY APPROVE OR REJECT THE PROPOSAL OR DETERMINE TO ISSUE IT AS AN EXECUTIVE ORDER. IF THE GOVERNOR APPROVES THE ORDER, IT IS EFFECTIVE ON HIS APPROVAL OR AT THE LATER DATE PROVIDED IN THE PROPOSAL. AN APPROVED PROPOSAL IS TREATED AS AN EXECUTIVE ORDER FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE. IF THE GOVERNOR ISSUES IT AS AN EXECUTIVE ORDER, IT BECOMES EFFECTIVE AS IN THE CASE OF OTHER EXECUTIVE ORDERS.

15CC.

(A) UPON THE ISSUANCE OF AN EXECUTIVE ORDER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL CAUSE THE ORIGINAL OR A CERTIFIED COPY TO BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

(B) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PREPARE AND MAINTAIN AN INDEX OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS FILED IN HIS OFFICE AND RETAIN THEM DURING THE TERM OF OFFICE (INCLUDING A SUBSEQUENT CONSECUTIVE TERM OF OFFICE) OF THE GOVERNOR WHO CAUSED THEM TO BE FILED.

(C) UPON THE TERMINATION OF THE PERIOD FOR RETENTION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DELIVER THEM TO THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION, FOR PRESERVATION OR OTHER DISPOSITION IN THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSION.

15CD.

AN AMENDMENT TO AN EXECUTIVE ORDER SHALL BE PREPARED SO AS TO SHOW THE ADDITION OR DELETION OF MATERIAL IN THE SAME MANNER AS A PROPOSED BILL IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

15CE.

(A) WITHIN TEN DAYS FOLLOWING THE [[ADJOURNMENT SINE DIE OF EACH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY]]
