

Commission at least quarterly, and oftener if requested, as to the amount of the fund in his hands.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 609

(House Bill 1116)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 11-101(3) of Article 66-1/2 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Vehicle Laws," subtitle "11. Rules of the Road," subheading "Part I. Obedience to and Effect of Traffic Laws," to include Dorchester County in the list of counties that prohibit motor vehicle operations on private as well as public property.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 11-101(3) of Article 66-1/2 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Vehicle Laws," subtitle "11. Rules of the Road," subheading "Part I. Obedience to and Effect of Traffic Laws," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

11-101.

(3) In Allegany, Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Calvert, Caroline, Carroll, Cecil, Charles, DORCHESTER, Frederick, Harford, Howard, Kent, Montgomery, Prince George's, St. Mary's, Talbot, Washington, and Wicomico counties any person operating a motor vehicle on private property and in Montgomery County on any property owned by the Board of Education or Montgomery College which is used by the public in general in violation of the provisions of this subtitle shall be deemed in violation of the law to the same extent as if the motor vehicle were being operated on a public highway and the violation carries the same penalty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 610

(House Bill 1147)

AN ACT to add new Section 268A to Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments," subtitle "I. Crimes and Punishments," subheading "Gunning," to follow immediately after Section 268 thereof, to prohibit the gunning of any game in Harford County without written leave or license of the owners of property hunted upon and prescribe penalties for violation of this prohibition.
