CHAPTER 619

(House Bill 1283)

CHAPTER 620

(House Bill 1284)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 402(a) and (b) of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1966 Replacement Volume and 1971 Supplement), title "Corporations", subtitle "Particular Classes of Corporations", subheading "Electric Cooperatives", to add any other financing institution to those institutions the Board of Directors may execute mortgages to in order to secure indebtedness; and to more explicitly provide for notice to members of meetings at which a majority can authorize sale, lease or disposal of cooperative property; and to delete mortgages or encumbrances from the members' authority.
