

(d) ["Disposal system" means a system for disposing of wastes, either by surface or underground methods, and includes treatment works, disposal wells or other systems.]

"EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS" MEANS ANY RESTRICTIONS OR PROHIBITIONS ESTABLISHED UNDER STATE OR FEDERAL LAW INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PARAMETERS FOR TOXIC AND NONTXIC DISCHARGES, STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE FOR NEW SOURCES, OR OCEAN DISCHARGE CRITERIA. THE RESTRICTIONS OR PROHIBITIONS SHALL SPECIFY QUANTITIES, RATES, AND CONCENTRATIONS OR CHEMICAL, PHYSICAL, BIOLOGICAL, AND OTHER CONSTITUENTS WHICH ARE DISCHARGED INTO STATE WATERS.

(e) "Waters of the State" means both surface and underground waters within the boundaries of the State or subject to its jurisdiction, including that portion of the Atlantic Ocean within the boundaries of the State, the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, the [flood plain] FLOODPLAIN of free-flowing waters on the basis of a fifty (50) year flood frequency, and all ponds, lakes, rivers, streams, public ditches, tax ditches, and public drainage systems within the State, other than those designed and used for the purpose of collection, conveyance, or disposal of sanitary sewage.

(f) "Person" means the State or any agency or institution thereof, any municipality, political subdivision, public or private corporation, individual partnership, association, or other entity, and includes any officer or governing or managing body of any municipality, political subdivision, or public or private corporation.

(G) "DISPOSAL SYSTEM" MEANS A SYSTEM FOR DISPOSING OF WASTES, EITHER BY SURFACE, ABOVE SURFACE OR UNDERGROUND METHODS, AND INCLUDES TREATMENT WORKS, DISPOSAL WELLS, AND OTHER SYSTEMS.

(H) "SCHEDULE OF COMPLIANCE" MEANS A SCHEDULE OF REMEDIAL MEASURES INCLUDING AN ENFORCEABLE SEQUENCE OF ACTIONS OR OPERATIONS LEADING TO COMPLIANCE WITH THE EFFLUENT LIMITATION OR WATER QUALITY STANDARD AS SPECIFIED BY AN ORDER OR PERMIT REQUIREMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

(I) "WATER QUALITY STANDARDS" MEANS ANY WATER QUALITY STANDARDS ADOPTED AND EFFECTIVE UNDER STATE AND FEDERAL LAW.

(J) "WATER QUALITY CRITERIA" MEANS ANY CRITERIA DESCRIBING THE REQUIRED QUALITY OF STATE WATERS ADOPTED UNDER STATE AND FEDERAL LAW.

(K) "PERMIT" MEANS A PERMIT TO DISCHARGE POLLUTANTS INTO [STATE] WATERS OF THE STATE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B) OR (C) OF SECTION 26 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(L) "INDUSTRIAL USER" MEANS ANY PERSON ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURE [OR SALE OF GOODS.]FABRICATION, ASSEMBLAGE AND SUCH OTHER CLASSES OF SIGNIFICANT PRODUCERS OF POLLUTANTS IDENTIFIED UNDER REGULATIONS ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR BY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE UNITED STATES
