financial institution and either in a copy thereof or in the confirmation handed or mailed to the prospective buyer when the retail credit account is established.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 132

(House Bill 131)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 3-803 of Article 66-1/2 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume), title "Vehicle Laws," subtitle "Subtitle 3 Certificates of Title and Registration of Vehicles," subheading "Part VIII. Fees Connected with Registration and Titling," to correct an obsolete reference in the vehicle laws of this State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3-803 of Article 66-1/2 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume), title "Vehicle Laws," subtitle "Subtitle 3 Certificates of Title and Registration of Vehicles," subheading "Part VIII. Fees Connected with Registration and Titling," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

3-803.

A fee of \$60.00 each shall be paid for all passenger motor vehicles operating for the purpose of transporting persons for hire upon any of the public highways and streets of the State other than motor vehicles operating on fixed schedules, charter, funeral coaches, ambulances, mortician flower coaches, funeral limousines, and mortician service wagons, and others for which the registration fees are fixed by other specific provisions of this part. All such vehicles shall be classified as Class B vehicles. [This section shall not apply to vehicles for which fees are paid pursuant to Section 3-835.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 133

(House Bill 132)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 5-202 of Article 66-1/2 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume AND 1972 SUPPLEMENT), title "Vehicle Laws," subtitle "Subtitle 5 Licensing of Dealers, Wreckers, Scrap Processors I land 11, Vehicle Salesmen, [1"] MANUFACTURERS, DISTRIBUTORS AND FACTORY BRANCHES," subheading "Part II. Wreckers and Scrap Processors," to require a certain fee to accompany an application for a duplicate wrecker's or scrap processor's license, and to make certain corrections therein.
