Post once in each of four successive weeks before the 12th day of August, 1972.

Charter Amendment 72-2

MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF BRENTWOOD, MARYLAND

A RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE to amend Section 6-14 of the Code of Public Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, (1963 Edition) titled, "Brentwood," and subtitled, "Officers; appointment, duties," being a part of the Charter of the Town of Brentwood, Maryland, and adding a new Section 6-14(f), providing that the Mayor and Town Council may contract with law enforcement agencies for police service within the corporate limits of Brentwood.
