A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT WITH AMENDMENTS SECTION 16-4 OF ARTICLE 1 OF THE CHARTER OF BRUNSWICK, TITLE "IN GENERAL", SUBTITLE "PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF TOWN ORDINANCES", (THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FREDERICK, MARYLAND) TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM FINE WHICH MAY BE FIXED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN, TO REMOVE THE PROVISION FOR THE CONFINEMENT OF A PARTY IN THE TOWN LOCKUP FOR FAILING TO PAY ANY SUCH FINES, AND REMOVING THE REFERENCE TO A TRIAL MAGISTRATE THEREFROM AND SUBTITUTING A JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARYLAND THEREFOR.

RESOLVED, that Section 16-4 of Article I of the Charter of Brunswick, Title "In General", Subtitle "Penalties for Violation of Town Ordinances", (Code of the County of Frederick, Maryland) be repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:
