

SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL. THE TOWN SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO EMPLOY SUCH LEGAL CONSULTANTS AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY FROM TIME TO TIME.

57-0 AUTHORITY TO EMPLOY PERSONNEL. THE TOWN SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO EMPLOY SUCH OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY TO EXECUTE THE POWERS AND DUTIES PROVIDED BY THIS CHARTER OR OTHER STATE LAW AND TO OPERATE THE TOWN GOVERNMENT.

58-0 RETIREMENT SYSTEM. THE TOWN SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO INCLUDE ITS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, OR ANY OF THEM, WITHIN ANY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PENSION SYSTEM UNDER THE TERMS OF WHICH THEY ARE ADMISSIBLE, AND TO PAY THE EMPLOYER'S SHARE OF THE COST OF SUCH ANY RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM OUT OF THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE TOWN.

59-0 COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES. THE COMPENSATION OF ALL EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS OF THE TOWN SHALL BE SET FROM TIME TO TIME BY A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL, SUBJECT TO THE RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED UPON ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL.

60-0 EMPLOYEES BENEFITS PROGRAM. THE TOWN IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED BY ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR OR PARTICIPATE IN HOSPITALIZATION OR ANY OTHER FORMS OF BENEFIT OR WELFARE PROGRAMS FOR ITS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, AND TO EXPEND PUBLIC MONIES OF THE TOWN FOR SUCH PROGRAMS.

61-0 PUBLIC WAYS AND SIDEWALKS (DEFINITION). THE TERM "PUBLIC WAYS" AS USED IN THIS CHARTER SHALL INCLUDE ALL STREETS, AVENUES, ROADS, HIGHWAYS, PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES, LANES AND ALLEYS.

62-0 CONTROL OF PUBLIC WAYS. THE TOWN SHALL HAVE CONTROL OF ALL PUBLIC WAYS IN THE TOWN EXCEPT SUCH AS MAY BE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MARYLAND STATE ROADS COMMISSION. SUBJECT TO THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THIS CHARTER, THE TOWN MAY DO WHATEVER IT DEEMS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN IN GOOD CONDITION THE PUBLIC WAYS OF THE TOWN.

63-0 PUBLIC WAYS - POWERS. THE TOWN SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO:

63-1. TO ESTABLISH, REGULATE, AND CHANGE FROM TIME TO TIME THE GRADE LINES, WIDTH, AND CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS OF ANY TOWN PUBLIC WAY OR PART THEREOF, BRIDGE, CURBS AND GUTTERS.

63-2. TO GRADE, LAY OUT, CONSTRUCT, OPEN, EXTEND, CLOSE AND MAKE NEW TOWN PUBLIC WAYS.

63-3. TO GRADE, STRAIGHTEN, WIDEN, ALTER, IMPROVE OR CLOSE UP ANY EXISTING TOWN PUBLIC WAY OR PART THEREOF.
