e. That each of the following owners will, upon demand of the Town of Hampstead, convey to the said Town a parcel of their land, containing one-half acre, more or less, Said parcels to be used as a source of additional water for the municipal water system. Carroll County General Hospital, Inc., Earl W. Schultz, Leonard Rapoport and Yale Goldman.

And be it further RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective on the 46th day following its final enactment.
