

issuance of such bond anticipation notes; providing for covenants concerning the payment of the principal and interest of such bond anticipation notes; and generally relating to the issuance and sale of bond anticipation notes by the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City.

Copies of the proposed charter amendment are posted in the office of T. Earl Pierce, Clerk-Treasurer, in the Municipal Building, at Third Street and Baltimore Avenue, in the town of Ocean City.

This amendment will become effective on April 29, 1969, unless a petition for a referendum on the amendment, signed by twenty percent (20%) of the qualified voters of the town of Ocean City is filed with the Clerk-Treasurer on or before the 19th day of April, 1969.

OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND
