

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

REQUIREMENTS:

(1) THE APPLICANT HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A TRAINING COURSE APPROVED BY THE APPROVING AUTHORITY (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN HIGH SCHOOL, COLLEGE OR BY CORRESPONDENCE) QUALIFYING HIM TO OPERATE A SWIMMING POOL.

(2) SAID APPLICANT SHALL DEMONSTRATE SAID ABILITY BY PASSING AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE APPROVING AUTHORITY.

(3) THE APPLICANT SHALL FURNISH PROOF OF THREE (3) YEARS OF PRIOR EXPERIENCE IN THE OPERATION OF A PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL.

(B) SUCH LICENSE MAY BE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED BY THE APPROVING AUTHORITY FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, PROVIDED THE LICENSEE IS GIVEN (I) WRITTEN NOTICE BY CERTIFIED MAIL OF THE REASONS THEREFOR, AND (II) AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD ON THE MERITS. A DECISION SHALL BE HANDED DOWN NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) DAYS FOLLOWING SUCH HEARING.

SECTION 12-2104

NO PERSON LESS THAN SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF AGE SHALL ACT AS A PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL LIFEGUARD, AND SUCH PERSON SHALL BE DULY LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS AND PERMITS PURSUANT TO THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE APPROVING AUTHORITY BASED ON A FINDING THAT THE APPLICANT HAS A CURRENT SENIOR LIFE SAVING CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS, THE YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION, OR SOME OTHER AGENCY ACCEPTABLE TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY. APPLICATION FOR SAID LICENSE MAY BE FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONS AND PERMITS; NO FEE SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH LICENSE. NO PERSON SHALL SIMULTANEOUSLY FULFILL THE FUNCTION OF OPERATOR AND LIFEGUARD, WHILE PEOPLE ARE IN THE WATER.

SECTION 12-2105

(A) THE APPROVING AUTHORITY SHALL MAKE SUCH INSPECTIONS OF THE FACILITIES AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR PROPER. [[THE LICENSE]] SUBJECT TO THE CONFIRMATION OF THE APPROVING AUTHORITY, THE PERMIT TO OPERATE A POOL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION IF THE INSPECTOR HAS REASONABLE GROUNDS TO BELIEVE THAT ANY
