

ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Section 13-343.18

(6) [The density of any mobile home park shall not exceed that permitted in the district in which said park is situate; but no] NO park shall exceed seven (7) mobile home sites per acre.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law.

AN ORDINANCE to [[repeal and re-enact, with amendments,]] add new Sections 13-400 through 13-403, inclusive, to the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 13, "Planning and Zoning", to follow immediately after Rule XVIII of Section 13-360 thereof and to be under the new Subtitle 4, "General Development Plan"; to amend the General Development Plan for Anne Arundel County, Maryland, [[as]] in the Odenton area (said plan having been adopted by Bill No. 6-68 and amended by [[Bill No. 95-69, to amend the General Development Plan for Anne Arundel County in the Odenton area]] Bills Nos. 95-69 and 79-71); and to codify said plan amendments.

WHEREAS, The County Council of Anne Arundel County had directed the Office of Planning and Zoning to prepare a General Development Plan to shed light on the impact of the future growth in the County; and
