SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law, provided that the provisions thereof shall be applied retroactively to the weekly pay period [[next succeeding]] BEGINNING July 3, 1972 and to the bi-weekly pay period next succeeding June 30, 1972.

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Section 1-216.2 (a) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 1, "Administration", Subtitle 2, "Personnel", Article II, "Classified Service", and to enact new Section 1-216.2 (a) in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the section repealed, increasing the compensation of certain County employees within the Public Safety Pay Schedule.
