

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

PERCENT (100%) OF THE PARTICIPANT'S BASIC RATE OF EARNINGS IN EFFECT AS OF HIS DATE OF DISABILITY. HOWEVER, IN NO INSTANCE SHALL THE AMOUNT OF PENSION BE REDUCED BELOW THE AMOUNT OF ACCRUED PENSION CREDITED TO THE PARTICIPANT ON THE DATE DISABILITY PENSION PAYMENTS COMMENCE.

(3) IF THE PARTICIPANT IS DEEMED TO BE TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED SOLELY BECAUSE HE IS PREVENTED FROM CONTINUING IN HIS CAPACITY AS AN EMPLOYEE AS A RESULT OF A NON-DUTY RELATED CAUSE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) (2) OF THIS SECTION, THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF HIS DISABILITY PENSION SHALL BE EQUAL TO HIS ACCRUED PENSION AS OF HIS DATE OF DISABILITY COMPUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 14-302 (A), OR TWENTY PERCENT (20%) OF HIS FINAL EARNINGS (WHICHEVER IS GREATER).

(4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, BENEFITS RECEIVED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BY BENEFITS RECEIVED UNDER THE MARYLAND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

SECTION 2A. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE APPLICABLE TO EMPLOYEES RECEIVING DISABILITY BENEFITS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law.

AN ORDINANCE to add new Section 17-203(a-1) to the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 17, "Taxation," Subtitle 2, "Assessment and Levy," to follow immediately after Section 17-203 (a) thereof, to provide a tax credit for certain homeowners, and matters generally related thereto.
