

OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS, AND THE ISSUANCE AND SALE THEREOF, AND MAY AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE COMMISSIONERS OF FINANCE BY RESOLUTION TO DETERMINE AND SET FORTH ANY AND ALL OF THE THINGS HEREINABOVE MENTIONED, AND TO DO ANY AND ALL THINGS NECESSARY, PROPER, OR EXPEDIENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF THE NOTES, BONDS, OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS AUTHORIZED TO BE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUB-PARAGRAPH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 191

(House Bill 1529)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 150(a-1) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "Boards of License Commissioners," to provide for an annual salary of \$600 to the chairman and \$500 to the other members of the Board of License Commissioners.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 150(a-1) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "Boards of License Commissioners," is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

150.

(a-1) In Cecil County, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint three other persons, all of whom are to be of high moral character and possess a sound reputation for integrity, who shall constitute the board of license commissioners for the county; the members of the board shall designate their own chairman; the first members of said board to be appointed for three-, four- and five-year terms, respectively, and their successors thereafter for terms of five years each. The board of license commissioners shall meet at least once a month. THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600) AND THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE OTHER COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500). and each member shall receive no compensation but EACH shall ALSO be entitled to necessary expenses in connection with [their] HIS duties to be paid by the Commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.
