

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, That subsection (j) of Section 17-37 of the Baltimore County Code, 1968, title "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Article IV. Parking Meters, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

(j) Pikesville District, being that area bound on the west by a line [one hundred twenty-five] FIVE HUNDRED feet west of Reisterstown Road, on the north by the north property line of Old Court Road RELOCATED, on the east by [the east property line of Reisterstown Road] A LINE FIVE HUNDRED FEET EAST OF REISTERSTOWN ROAD and on the south by the [south property line of Clarendon Avenue] BALTIMORE CITY—BALTIMORE COUNTY BOUNDARY LINE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect forty-five days after its enactment.
