

BALTIMORE COUNTY

SECTION 13-116. SAME; SERVICE

SERVICE OF THE NOTICE PROVIDED IN SECTION 13-115 TO ANY PERSON OR PERSONS WITHIN BALTIMORE COUNTY MAY BE MADE BY REGISTERED MAIL OR BY ANY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER. IF THE OWNER OR OTHER PERSON HAVING CHARGE OF SUCH LANDS IS A NONRESIDENT WHOSE ADDRESS IS KNOWN SUCH NOTICE SHALL BE SENT TO HIS ADDRESS BY REGISTERED MAIL. IF THE ADDRESS OF ANY OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CHARGE OF SUCH LOT OR LANDS CANNOT BE LOCATED AFTER DILIGENT SEARCH IT SHALL BE SUFFICIENT TO POST SUCH NOTICE ON THE LOT OR LAND.

[[Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect forty-five days after its enactment.]]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AFFECTING THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR WELFARE, AND HAVING BEEN PASSED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL, THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF ITS ENACTMENT.

AN ACT to add a portion of the Eighth Election District to the Baltimore County Metropolitan District by adding subsection (e) to Section 34-11 of the Baltimore County Code, 1968, title "Water, Sewers, Sewage Disposal and Drains," Article III. Metropolitan District.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, That subsection (e) be and it is hereby added to Section 34-11 of the Baltimore County Code, 1968, title "Water, Sewers, Sewage Disposal and Drains," Article III. Metropolitan District, to read as follows:

(E) THE AREA HEREIN DESCRIBED IS HEREBY ADDED TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT:
