21.904 - FUNERAL PROCESSIONS TO BE IDENTIFIED

A FUNERAL COMPOSED OF A PROCESSION OF VEHICLES SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS SUCH BY THE DISPLAY UPON THE OUTSIDE OF FACH VEHICLE OF A PENNANT OR OTHER IDENTIFYING INSIGNIA OR BY SUCH OTHER METHOD AS MAY BE DETERMINED AND DESIGNATED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

SUBTITLE 11

PEDESTRIANS' RIGHTS AND DUTIES

21.1101 - CROSSING AT RIGHT ANGLES

EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE INDICATED BY A CROSSWALK OR OTHER OFFICIAL TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES, A PEDESTRIAN SHALL CROSS A ROADWAY AT RIGHT ANGLES TO A CURB OR BY THE SHORTEST ROUTE TO THE OPPOSITE CURB.

21.1102 - [[PROHIBITED CROSSING]] RESERVED

[[NO PEDESTRIAN SHALL CROSS A ROADWAY OTHER THAN IN A CROSSWALK IN ANY BUSINESS DISTRICT.]]

21.1103 - OBEDIENCE OF PEDESTRIANS TO BRIDGE AND RAILROAD SIGNALS

- (A) NO PEDESTRIAN SHALL ENTER OR REMAIN UPON ANY BRIDGE OR APPROACH THERETO BEYOND THE BRIDGE SIGNAL, GATE, OR BARRIER AFTER A BRIDGE OPERATION SIGNAL INDICATION HAS BEEN GIVEN.
- (B) NO PEDESTRIAN SHALL PASS THROUGH, AROUND, OVER, OR UNDER ANY CROSSING GATE OR BARRIER AT A RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING OR BRIDGE WHILE SUCH GATE OR BARRIER IS CLOSED OR IS BEING OPENED OR CLOSED.

21.1104 - DRIVERS TO EXERCISE DUE CARE

NOTWITHSTANDING OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT EVERY DRIVER OF A VEHICLE SHALL EXERCISE DUE CARE TO AVOID COLLIDING WITH ANY PEDESTRIAN UPON ANY ROADWAY AND SHALL GIVE WARNING BY SOUNDING THE HORN WHEN NECESSARY AND SHALL EXERCISE PROPER PRECAUTION UPON OBSERVING ANY CHILD OR ANY OBVIOUSLY CONFUSED OR INCAPACITATED PERSON UPON A ROADWAY.
