HOWARD COUNTY

21.2002 - UNIFORMITY OF INTERPRETATION

THIS ACT SHALL BE SO INTERPRETED AND CONSTRUED AS TO EFFECTUATE ITS GENERAL PURPOSE TO MAKE UNIFORM THE LAW OF THOSE LOCAL AUTHORITIES WHO ENACT IT.

21.2003 - EFFECT OF HEADINGS

TITLE AND SECTION HEADINGS CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO GOVERN, LIMIT, MODIFY OR IN ANY MANNER AFFECT THE SCOPE, MEANING OR EXTENT OF THE PROVISIONS OF ANY TITLE OR SECTION HEREOF.

21.2004 - ACT NOT RETROACTIVE

THIS ACT SHALL NOT HAVE A RETROACTIVE EFFECT AND SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY TRAFFIC ACCIDENT, TO ANY CAUSE OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT OR JUDGEMENT ARISING THEREFROM, OR TO ANY VIOLATION OF THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ACT OF THIS COUNTY, OCCURRING PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.

21.2005 - EFFECT OF PARTIAL INVALIDITY

IF ANY PART OR PARTS OF THIS ACT ARE FOR ANY REASON HELD TO BE INVALID, SUCH DECISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINING PORTIONS OF THIS ACT.

21.2101 - ONE-WAY STREETS

(A) TIBER ALLEY

HAMILTON STREET

FORREST STREET
