

## HOWARD COUNTY

GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL PLUS ADVANCED COURSES IN PENOLOGY AND/OR CORRECTIONAL MANAGEMENT PRACTICE AND FIVE (5) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN PENAL, CORRECTIONAL OR CLOSELY RELATED WORK, INCLUDING TWO (2) YEARS IN A RESPONSIBLE ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY OR AN EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE.

## (102) CORRECTIONAL OFFICER

GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; OR COMPLETION OF THE EIGHTH GRADE, PLUS FOUR (4) YEARS CORRECTIONAL, PENAL, POLICE, MILITARY OR RELATED GUARD OR SECURITY EXPERIENCE; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE.

## J. RECREATION AND PARKS

## (103) RECREATION SUPERVISOR

GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY PREFERABLY WITH A MAJOR IN RECREATION OR A RELATED FIELD, PLUS TWO (2) YEARS EXPERIENCE AS A RECREATIONAL LEADER, RECREATION CENTER DIRECTOR OR SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES.

## (104) RECREATION CENTER COORDINATOR

GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY PREFERABLY WITH A MAJOR IN RECREATION OR A RELATED FIELD, PLUS ONE (1) YEAR EXPERIENCE AS A RECREATIONAL LEADER, RECREATION CENTER DIRECTOR OR SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF HOWARD COUNTY, MARYLAND, That this Act shall take effect sixty (60) days after its enactment.

This Bill, having been approved by the Executive and returned to Council, stands enacted on June 7, 1972.

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
