

## COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

(G) HOSPITALS, SANITARIUMS, NURSING HOMES, CARE HOMES, AND ANY OTHER TYPES OF SIMILAR INSTITUTIONS WHICH ALREADY ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A STATE OR COUNTY LICENSE FOR THE BUILDINGS OR PREMISES IN WHICH THEY ARE OPERATED SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A FACILITY LICENSE. A DRUG-RELATED PROGRAM LICENSE SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR SUCH INSTITUTIONS WHO HAVE AS A SEPARATE PART OF THEIR ACTIVITIES A PROGRAM FOR THE CARE, TREATMENT, OR REHABILITATION OF DRUG-DEPENDENT PERSONS.

## SECTION 8A-7. FEES; TERMS OF LICENSE.

EACH LICENSE SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE. THE LICENSES SHALL BE RENEWED ANNUALLY. NO FURTHER INVESTIGATION SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR RENEWAL OF PROGRAM LICENSES; PROVIDED WHEN AT ANY TIME THERE HAS BEEN A CHANGE OF PERSONNEL OR CIRCUMSTANCES, THE DIRECTOR MAY CONDUCT A REINVESTIGATION AND REQUIRE A NEW LICENSE. THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A DRUG-RELATED PROGRAM AND THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A DRUG-RELATED FACILITY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME BY WRITTEN ORDER OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE REASONABLE COST OF SUCH LICENSING.

## SECTION 8A-8. CHANGE OF LOCATION; TRANSFER OF LICENSE.

WHENEVER A FACILITY CHANGES ITS LOCATION TO A DIFFERENT BUILDING OR PREMISES WHICH HAS NOT YET BEEN INSPECTED OR LICENSED, THE CURRENT LICENSE HELD FOR THE FACILITY SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BECOME VOID. PRIOR TO CHANGING ITS LOCATION, THE LICENSEE SHALL MAKE APPLICATION FOR A NEW FACILITY LICENSE TO THE OFFICE AND COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF FOR SUCH LICENSE. THE FEE FOR TRANSFER OF SUCH LICENSE SHALL BE AS ESTABLISHED FROM TIME TO TIME BY THE WRITTEN ORDER OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE REASONABLE COST OF SUCH LICENSING.

## SECTION 8A-9. DENIAL, SUSPENSION, REVOCATION OF LICENSES.

THE DIRECTOR MAY REVOKE OR SUSPEND ANY PROGRAM LICENSE OR FACILITY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS CHAPTER UPON A FINDING THAT THE PROGRAM OR FACILITY NO LONGER COMPLIES WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR HAVE BECOME IN VIOLATION OF APPLICABLE STANDARDS OR LAWS OF THE STATE AND COUNTY AND THAT THE RETENTION OF SUCH
