OR SODDED AS SOON AS THE SEASON PERMITS.

C. A FILL WHICH:

1. IS LESS THAN FOUR (4) FEET IN VERTICAL HEIGHT AT ITS DEEPEST POINT AS MEASURED FROM THE NATURAL GROUND SURFACE,

2. IS PLACED ON A SURFACE HAVING A SLOPE NOT STEEPER THAN FIVE (5) FEET HORIZONTAL TO ONE (1) FOOT VERTICAL,

3. DOES NOT EXCEED A TOTAL OF 100 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL ON ANY LOT, PARCEL OR SUBDIVISION THEREOF,

4. DOES NOT IMPAIR EXISTING SURFACE DRAINAGE, CONSTITUTE A POTENTIAL EROSION HAZARD OR ACT AS A SOURCE OF SEDIMENTATION TO ANY ADJACENT LAND OR WATERCOURSE,

5. HAS NO FINAL SLOPES STEEPER THAN ONE (1) FOOT VERTICAL IN THREE (3) FEET HORIZONTAL, AND

6. HAS ALL DISTURBED AREAS PROMPTLY SEEDED OR SODDED AS SOON AS THE SEASON PERMITS.

D. ACCEPTED AGRICULTURAL LAND MANAGEMENT PRACTICES SUCH AS:

1. PLOWING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF AGRICULTURAL STRUCTURES,

2. NURSERY OPERATIONS SUCH AS THE REMOVAL AND/OR TRANSPLANTING OF CULTIVATED SOD, SHRUBS, AND TREES AND TREE CUTTING AT OR ABOVE EXISTING GROUND, AND LOGGING OPERATIONS LEAVING THE STUMP, GROUND COVER AND ROOT MAT INTACT.

E. QUARRY OPERATIONS SUBJECT TO CHAPTER 98, "QUARRIES", MONTGOMERY COUNTY CODE 1965, AND THE STOCKPILING WITH SLOPES AT A NATURAL ANGLE OF REPOSE, OF RAW OR PROCESSED SAND, STONE AND GRAVEL AT QUARRIES, CONCRETE, ASPHALT AND MATERIAL PROCESSING PLANT AND STORAGE YARDS, PROVIDING SEDIMENT AND EROSION MEASURES HAVE BEEN AND ARE BEING EMPLOYED TO PROTECT AGAINST OFF-SITE DAMAGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH A GRADING, EROSION, AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN APPROVED BY THE DISTRICT.
