MONTGOMERY COUNTY

SECTION 83A-11. REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF PERMIT.

- A. ANY PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS CHAPTER MAY BE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED BY THE DIRECTOR AFTER NOTICE FOR:
- 1. VIOLATION OF ANY CONDITION OF THE PERMIT:
- 2. VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW, ORDINANCE, BULE OR REGULATION RELATING TO THE WORK; AND
- 3. EXISTENCE OF ANY CONDITION OR THE DOING OF ANY ACT CONSTITUTING OR CREATING A NUISANCE, HAZARD OR ENDANGERING HUMAN LIFE OR THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS.

SECTION 83A-12. PERMIT-EXPIRATION-RENEWAL.

EVERY PERMIT ISSUED HEREUNDER SHALL EXPIRE AT THE END OF THE PERIOD OF TIME SET OUT IN THE PERMIT. PERMITTEE SHALL FULLY PERFORM AND COMPLETE ALL OF THE WORK REQUIRED TO BE DONE WITHIN THE TIME LIMIT SPECIFIED IN THE PERMIT. IF THE PERMITTEE SHALL BE UNABLE TO COMPLETE THE WORK WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TIME. HE SHALL, WITHIN THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO EXPIRATION OF THE PERMIT, PRESENT IN WRITING TO THE DEPARTMENT A REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME, SETTING FORTH THEREIN THE REASONS FOR THE REQUESTED EXTENSION. IF THE DISCRETION OF THE DIRECTOR, SUCH AN EXTENSION IS WARRANTED, HE MAY GRANT ADDITIONAL TIME FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE WORK FOR AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF TEN PERCENT OF THE ORIGINAL FEE. WHERE THE DIRECTOR DETERMINES THAT THE EXTENSION OF TIME WILL REQUIRE A SUBSTANTIAL MODIFICATION OF THE GRADING, EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN, ANY EXTENSION OF A PERMIT SHALL SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF A REVISED GRADING. EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN BY THE DISTRICT.

SECTION 83A-13. INSPECTION.

- A. NO WORK SHALL PROCEED UNTIL INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL FILE A REPORT THEREON. ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN INSPECTION AND CONSTRUCTION CONTROL SCHEDULE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- B. AFTER COMMENCING INITIAL GRADING OPERATIONS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSPECT AT THE FOLLOWING STAGES IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SITE, OR OF EACH SUBDIVISION THEREOF:
