bond," Section 40-3, title "Submission of requests for funds; granting not mandatory," of Chapter 40, title "Sandy Spring"; Section 41-1, title "Area defined," Section 41-2, title "Annual levy; treasurer's bond and duties," of Chapter 41, title "Silver Spring"; Section 42-1, title "Special levy on Precinct 22 for fire protection," of Chapter 42, title "Takoma Park"; and existing Section 43-1, title "Area defined; annual levy," Section 43-2, title "Procedure for making annual levy," Section 43-3, title "Treasurer's duties, bond, etc.," of Chapter 43, title "Upper Montgomery County," of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended, are hereby repealed in their entirety as obsolete.

SECTION 2. Section 2-83, title "Fire Board," Article XIII, title "Advisory Boards," Chapter 2, title "Administration," of Title I, title "General Local Laws," of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Sec. 2-83. Fire Board.

(a) Fire Board Established and Membership.

There is herery established a Montgomery County Fire Board to be composed of the chief of each fire department and rescue squad within the County, including the chief of the fire department of the City of Takoma Park, Maryland, and one elected delegate from each fire department and each rescue squad said delegate to be elected annually in June among the membership of the respective departments and squads except as to the second delegate from the City of Takoma Park. The second delegate from the City of Takoma Park shall be appointed by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Takoma Park from nominations submitted to them by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. Any vacancy occurring among delegates shall be filled within 30 days by the squad, department, or city in the manner of the original election or appointment. Such delegate shall serve until the next annual The chiefs and elected delegates will vote election. as individual representatives of their respective departments and squads and shall not be bound by their departments' or squads' decision in any vote which
