ACTIVITIES AND FUNCTIONS CONCERNED WITH INSPECTION AND LICENSES UNLESS OTHERWISE PRESCRIBED BY LAW.

- 1. ZONING ORDINANCE, ETC. THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND OTHER REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR THE COUNCIL UNDER THE MARYLAND-WASHINGTON REGIONAL DISTRICT ACT AND OF ANY ORDINANCE OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL UNDER ARTICLE 66B OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, 1957, AS NOW OR HEREAFTER AMENDED.
- 2. CODES, ETC., ADOPTED UNDER SECTION 2-24. THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF ANY STANDARD, CODE OR REGULATION, ADOPTED UNDER SECTION 2-24 OF THIS CODE.
- 3. ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF ALL OTHER CODES AS PREVIOUSLY PRESCRIBED BY LAW, ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTION AND LICENSES OR THE DIRECTOR THEREOF.

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPUTY STATE HEALTH OFFICER WITH ASSISTANCE IN THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF STATE HEALTH LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTIONS 8 AND 9, ARTICLE 43, OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, AS AMENDED, OR OTHERWISE HERETOFORE OR HEREAFTER PRESCRIBED BY APPLICABLE PUBLIC GENERAL LAW.

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SHALL MAKE REGULAR REPORTS TO AND FURNISH SUCH INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER STATE LAW TO THE DEPUTY STATE HEALTH OFFICER.

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SHALL PROVIDE ALL PERTINENT PROGRAM AND FISCAL INFORMATION TO THE DEPUTY STATE HEALTH OFFICER FOR HIS REVIEW AND APPROVAL FOR ALL PROGRAMS FINANCIALLY SUPPORTED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

SECTION 13. A new Section 2-16E, title "Administration," subtitle "Reference To" "Division of Sanitation," "Division of Environmental Health," "Department of Health," or "County Health Officer" to mean "Department of Environmental Protection" or "Director of Department of Environmental Protection"
