CHAIRMAN AND ANOTHER OF ITS MEMBERS AS VICE-CHAIRMAN, EACH TO SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION, AND OTHER OFFICERS AS IT SHALL DETERMINE. COMMISSION SHALL MEET ON CALL BY THE CHAIRMAN AS PREQUENTLY AS REQUIRED TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES BUT NOT LESS THAN ONCE EACH MONTH. A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS, AND A MAJORITY VOTE OF THOSE PRESENT, BUT NOT LESS THAN FOUR, AT ANY MEETING SHALL BE SUFFICIENT FOR ANY OFFICIAL ACTION TAKEN BY THE COMMISSION. WHEN A MEMBER IS ABSENT. THE ALTERNATE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS THE SAME GROUP SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMISSION PROCEEDING IN PLACE OF THE ABSENT MEMBER. AT THE REQUEST OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS. A REGULAR OR EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE CONVENED.

93A-11. COMMISSION; COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF MEMBERS.

MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE COMPENSATED AT THE RATE OF THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) PER MEETING ATTENDED PER DAY AS A VOTING MEMBER, NOT TO EXCEED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) PER INDIVIDUAL PER ANNUM, AND SHALL BE BEIMEURSED FOR ALL ACTUAL EXPENSES NECESSARILY INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY, BY RESOLUTION, CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION.

93A-12. COMMISSION: STAFF SERVICES.

THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF LANDLORD-TENANT AFFAIRS, OR OTHERWISE, IF SUCH SERVICES ARE NOT AVAILABLE OR SUFFICIENT FROM THAT OFFICE, SHALL PROVIDE HOUSEKEEPING, SECRETARIAL AND STAFF SERVICES TO THE COMMISSION.

- 93A-13. COMMISSION; EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS, COMMITTEES, ADVISORY COMMITTEES.
- (A) THE COMMISSION MAY, IN ITS DISCRETION, APPOINT NON-VOTING EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS TO ASSIST IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS DUTIES.
- (B) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION MAY, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION, APPOINT COMMITTEES FROM ITS MEMBERS TO ASSIST IN CARRYING OUT ANY OF THE FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION. ANY COMMITTEE
