

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

APPOINTED SHALL CONSIST OF NOT LESS THAN THREE MEMBERS. COMMITTEE ACTION SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO BE THE ACTIONS OF THE COMMISSION AND SHALL IN NO WAY BIND THE COMMISSION OR ITS MEMBERS.

(C) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION MAY APPOINT ADVISORY COMMITTEES OF CITIZENS AND AT LEAST ONE COMMISSION MEMBER AS IN HIS JUDGMENT WILL AID IN EFFECTUATING THE PURPOSES OF THIS CHAPTER. ADVISORY COMMITTEE ACTION SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO BE THE ACTIONS OF THE COMMISSION AND SHALL IN NO WAY BIND THE COMMISSION OR ITS MEMBERS.

93A-14. ADMINISTRATION; COOPERATION.

THE COMMISSION, OFFICE, OFFICE STAFF AND ALL COUNTY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES CONCERNED WITH HOUSING AND REAL PROPERTY MATTERS SHALL COOPERATE IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS CHAPTER. THE COMMISSION AND OFFICE ARE AUTHORIZED, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER, TO UTILIZE THE PERSONNEL AND FACILITIES OF OTHER DEPARTMENTS OF THE COUNTY IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER, AND THESE DEPARTMENTS SHALL MAKE THEIR RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO THE COMMISSION AND OFFICE AS NECESSARY.

93A-15. REPORTS TO COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL.

THE COMMISSION SHALL, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS FOLLOWING EACH QUARTER OF THE CALENDAR YEAR, REPORT TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL ON THE NUMBER OF COMPLAINTS FILED DURING SUCH QUARTER, THE NATURE THEREOF AND THE DISPOSITION MADE THEREOF; AND SHALL MAKE THIS INFORMATION PUBLIC AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE. THIS REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE TITLES OF ALL COURT CASES ARISING UNDER THIS CHAPTER.

ARTICLE III

LICENSING OF RENTAL FACILITIES

93A-16. LICENSING REQUIREMENT.

AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS CHAPTER, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO CONDUCT OR OPERATE WITHIN MONTGOMERY COUNTY A RENTAL FACILITY WITHOUT HAVING FIRST APPLIED FOR OR OBTAINED A LICENSE TO OPERATE OR CONDUCT SAID RENTAL FACILITY AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED. THE HOLDER OF A LICENSE SHALL BE THE OWNER OF THE
