

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

INDEBTED TO THE COUNTY, THE COUNCIL SHALL PROCEED FORTHWITH TO COLLECT THE INDEBTEDNESS. THE AUDITOR IS ALSO EMPOWERED TO CONDUCT PERFORMANCE AUDITS OF ANY AGENCY WHICH IS THE RECIPIENT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED OR APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL WHENEVER HE DEEMS IT APPROPRIATE, AND HE IS HEREBY DIRECTED TO CONDUCT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF EACH AGENCY AT LEAST ONCE EVERY FOUR YEARS. ANY AUDIT, INCLUDING PERFORMANCE AUDITS, SPECIAL AUDITS, AND STATE AUDITS WHICH FORM THE BASIS FOR AN EXEMPTION BY THE COUNCIL FROM A COUNTY AUDIT, SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN SUITABLE FORM AND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC AT REASONABLE HOURS AT THE OFFICE OF AUDITS AND INVESTIGATIONS. ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF COUNTY FUNDS BY ALL OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY AND ALL AGENCIES THEREOF, SHALL AT ALL TIMES BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION OF THE COUNTY AUDITOR. THE AUDITOR SHALL PROMPTLY CALL TO THE ATTENTION OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ANY IRREGULARITY OR IMPROPER PROCEDURE WHICH HE MAY DISCOVER. THE COUNCIL SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND TO ASSIGN ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS, DUTIES, AND PERSONNEL TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

SECTION 314. OTHER EMPLOYEES. THE COUNCIL MAY PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SUCH OTHER EMPLOYEES AS IT MAY DEEM DESIRABLE FOR THE EXERCISE OF ITS POWERS, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE IX OF THIS CHARTER.

SECTION 315. SPECIAL ASSISTANCE. THE COUNCIL MAY, AT ITS DISCRETION, AND SUBJECT TO ITS REGULAR OR SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET APPROPRIATION, EMPLOY SUCH LEGAL, FINANCIAL, OR OTHER TECHNICAL ADVISORS AS IT MAY FROM TIME TO TIME DEEM NECESSARY FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTIONS.

SECTION 316. COUNCIL SESSIONS. THE FIRST AND THIRD TUESDAYS OF EACH MONTH, EXCEPT NOVEMBER OF A COUNCILMANIC ELECTION YEAR, THE FIRST FIFTEEN DAYS IN APRIL OF EACH YEAR, AND SUCH ADDITIONAL DAYS AS THE COUNCIL MAY DETERMINE, ARE DESIGNATED AS DAYS FOR THE ENACTMENT OF LEGISLATION. FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING SUCH DUTIES, OTHER THAN ENACTING LEGISLATION, WHICH ARE PROPERLY EXERCISABLE BY THE COUNCIL UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHARTER, THE COUNCIL MAY SIT IN NON-LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS AT SUCH OTHER TIMES AS IT MAY DETERMINE. A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FULL COUNCIL SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS, EXCEPT THAT FOR
