

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

3. THE BENEFIT PERFORMANCE SHALL BE MANAGED AND OPERATED ONLY BY MEMBERS OF SUCH GROUP OR ORGANIZATION PERSONALLY EXCEPT THAT EMPLOYEES OF ANY PROFESSIONAL CARNIVAL OPERATION MAY OPERATE ALL RIDES AND TECHNICAL, MECHANICAL, AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND MAY OPERATE SPECIAL EQUIPMENT, SUCH AS POPCORN, COFFEE, AND CANDY MACHINES.

SEC. 50-4 (F). INSPECTION.

THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSES AND PERMITS SHALL CONDUCT AN INITIAL PRE-OPERATING INSPECTION AS WELL AS PERIODIC INSPECTIONS TO INSURE THAT THE PERMIT CONDITIONS ARE COMPLIED WITH.

SEC. 50-4 (G). PERMIT FEES. THE FEE FOR A BENEFIT CARNIVAL PERMIT SHALL BE \$15.00 PER RIDE WITH A MINIMUM OF \$100.00 FOR THE FIRST 7 DAYS AND \$100.00 PER WEEK, OR PORTIONS OF A WEEK, THEREAFTER. NO FEES SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR ANY BENEFIT PERFORMANCE OTHER THAN A CARNIVAL THAT IS TO BE A ONE-TIME OPERATION. ANY BENEFIT PERFORMANCE, OTHER THAN A CARNIVAL, THAT IS TO BE OPERATED REPEATEDLY SHALL HAVE A FEE OF \$50.00 PER YEAR.

SEC. 50-4 (H). GAMES PERMITTED.

PERMITTED GAMES SHALL BE LIMITED TO GAMES OF SKILL, MECHANICAL DEVICES SUCH AS PADDLE WHEELS, WHEELS OF FORTUNE, BINGO OR RAFFLES; HOWEVER, NO GAMES INVOLVING DICE SHALL BE PERMITTED.

SEC. 50-4 (I). PRIZES.

PRIZES SHALL BE LIMITED AS FOLLOWS:

1. MECHANICAL DEVICES— LIMITED TO \$20.00 IN CASH OR MERCHANDISE ON A PER GAME BASIS.
2. GAMES OF SKILL—LIMITED TO \$20.00 IN CASH OR MERCHANDISE ON A PER GAME BASIS.
3. BINGO—LIMITED TO \$50.00 IN CASH OR MERCHANDISE ON A PER GAME BASIS EXCEPT THAT A JACKPOT BINGO WITH A PRIZE LIMIT UP TO \$500.00 MAY BE AWARDED ONCE A NIGHT.
4. RAFFLE—LIMITED TO A \$5,000 PRIZE OF EITHER MERCHANDISE OR SERVICES. THE PRIZE MAY BE
